West Valley Community Services is a private nonprofit, community-based agency that for over 40 years has been providing direct assistance and referral services to the west valley communities of Cupertino, Los Gatos, Monte Sereno, Saratoga, West San Jose and the surrounding mountain regions. Founded in 1973, WVCS provides a continuum of basic needs, family support services and housing services including: information and referrals, food pantry, clothing, transitional housing, affordable housing, financial assistance, family support and case management services.

Over the past 45 years, we have changed the lives of thousands of families through our basic needs and safety-net services. As the only safety-net organization serving the west valley area of Santa Clara County, WVCS' reach is widespread. We help over 8,000 men, women and children every year, through our three core program areas: Health, Home, and Heart. More important than our reach is the impact WVCS has not only on the lives of those we serve, but also on solving critical issues such as access to nutrition food, affordable housing, family support, and reduction of poverty.

We are extremely grateful for the many partnerships we have with faith-based organizations around Cupertino and the County. We partner with several congregations to coordinate many of our special programs such as our Thanksgiving Basket program with St. Joseph's Church and our Gift of Hope: Holiday Gift Program in conjunction with West Valley Presbyterian Church. It is with these alliances that we are able to provide critical lifeline services to those in need.

WVCS is committed to a targeted, data driven collaborative effort to end poverty and homelessness in the west valley region, and is just about to launch a new collaborative initiative to provide mobile food pantry and case management services throughout our service area.
